Discrimination Policy

Wolverine Community Schools upholds and enforces the following:

No person, on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, or handicap shall be discriminated against, excluded from participation in, or be denied benefits of any program for which the board of education is responsible.

The district shall not provide "directory information" on a student to anyone other than to the parents of the student or an adult student. This includes name, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, photograph, student's major field of study, or any awards the student may of received.

Confidential records contain educational and behavioral information that has restricted access based on the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and Michigan law. This information can only be released with the written consent of the parents, the adult student, or a surrogate. The only exception to this is to comply with State and Federal laws that may require release without consent.
