### Position Overview

As the Varsity Head Coach, you will serve as the program leader for all levels of girls' volleyball in the district, including Varsity, Junior Varsity, Middle School, and Elementary tiers. You will be responsible for creating a structured, safe, and positive environment that encourages both athletic and personal growth.

### Key Responsibilities

- **Program Leadership:** Provide overarching direction and assistance to the entire girls' volleyball program across all age groups.
- **Scheduling & Communication:** Submit team practice schedules to the Athletic Director, and maintain open communication with parents regarding updates, bus times, or cancellations.
- **Student Accountability:** Enforce school policies, basic written team rules, and student dress codes. Document practice logs and adjust student playing time for absences or code violations.
- **Game Day Administration:** Report home game scores on MHSAA.com immediately after matches, and submit MHSAA Officials Ratings within required windows.
- **Logistics & Safety:** Ensure all players travel via approved school transportation and are only released post-game to a parent/guardian via a written signature. Ensure practices remain closed to non-team members.
- **Department Support:** Coordinate home game gate workers (covering JV matches) for home games.
- **Fundraising & Equipment:** Oversee approved team fundraising for non-school provided gear and proper care for district facilities, equipment, and keys.

### Required Qualifications

- Must meet all qualifications and requirements of the Revised School Code, state law, and the Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA).
- Must attend the annual MHSAA rules meeting (or pass the annual MHSAA rules test) and attend Northern Lakes Conference Coaches Meetings.

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills to work effectively with student-athletes, parents, and school administration.
- Must pass a standard district background check.
